## Translations of Psalm 109/110

## Augustine's text

- 1. The Lord said to my Lord, 'Sit at my right hand, until I make your enemies into your footstool.'
- 2. From Zion will the Lord send forth your scepter of power. Have dominion in the midst of your foes.
- 3. With you is the beginning, on the day of your strength in the splendor of the saints. From the womb before the morning star I begot you.
- 4. The Lord has sworn and will not revoke it: 'You are a priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.'
- 5. The Lord is at your right hand; he has shattered kings on the day of his anger.
- 6. He will execute judgment among the nations and rebuild (replebit) the ruins. He will shatter many heads on earth.
- 7. He will drink from the torrent beside the way and therefore he will raise<sup>2</sup> his head.

## **Douay Rheims**

- 1. The Lord said to my Lord: 'Sit thou at my right hand: Until I make thy enemies thy footstool.'
- 2. The Lord will send forth the sceptre of thy power out of Sion: rule thou in the midst of thy enemies.
- 3. With thee is the principality in the day of thy strength: in the brightness of the saints: from the womb before the day star I begot thee.
- 4. The Lord hath sworn, and he will not repent: 'Thou art a priest forever according to the order of Melchisedech.'
- 5. The Lord at thy right hand hath broken kings in the day of his wrath.
- **6.** He shall judge among nations, he shall fill (implebit) ruins: he shall crush the heads in the land of the many.
- 7. He shall drink of the torrent in the way: therefore shall he lift up the head.

## **New American Bible**

- 1. The LORD says to my lord: "Sit at my right hand, while I make your enemies your footstool."
- 2. The scepter of your might: the LORD extends your strong scepter from Zion. Have dominion over your enemies!
- 3. Yours is princely power from the day of your birth. In holy splendor before the daystar, like dew I begot you.3
- 4. The LORD has sworn and will not waver: "You are a priest forever in the manner of Melchizedek."
- 5. At your right hand is the Lord, who crushes kings on the day of his wrath,
- 6. Who judges nations, heaps up corpses, crushes heads across the wide earth,4
- 7. Who drinks from the brook by the wayside and thus holds high his head.
